

SUBJECT: POLICY ON PARTICIPATION

DATE: JUNE 16, 1982

With recommendation of the All-College Council, the following Policy on Participation is approved effective with the fall term of 1982:

In order to enhance the total learning process, the College will provide on-going extracurricular activities to the extent that such activities complement the student's academic development. Regulations governing student participation in extracurricular activities are:

- 1 - The student must not be on Academic Probation in order to participate in any extracurricular activity.
- 2 - At the beginning of each semester, the Director of Physical Education and the Director of Student Activities will check eligibility status of students as they apply to participate in student activities and will forward this to the Dean of Student Affairs.
- 3 - The Dean of Student Affairs will provide the opportunity for counseling services to ineligible students.
- 4 - Students may petition for reinstatement based upon extenuating circumstances to a Participation Appeals Panel consisting of the Dean of Student Affairs (non-voting), a student, the Director of Student Activities, the Physical Education Director, and a member of the Student Development Staff - the panel may recommend reinstatement to the Dean of Students who will take final action.
