Re: Clarification of Graduation Requirements

Following our discussion of several last minute requests for permission to participate in Commencement, I am taking this opportunity to confirm our discussion relative to our 1996 policy implementation.

- 1) All students who complete graduation requirements in August, December, or May, prior to the May Commencement, will be eligible to participate in the May Commencement ceremony.
- 2) All students whose program requirements extend beyond May of an academic year may participate in the May Commencement ceremony, upon recommendation of the program coordinator and the registrar, and upon validation of good academic standing. The academic officers should investigate the necessity of program continuance past May as opposed to beginning program coursework in August.
- 3) In addition, any student, who through circumstances beyond his/her control, has one course remaining to complete program requirements, may petition to participate in the graduation ceremony contingent upon enrollment in, and payment for, the final course requirement in summer school. Such student must be in good academic standing and must be recommended by both the program coordinator and the registrar. Excluded from this category are students who fail to complete a course (e.g. failure, withdrawal, etc.) in their final semester and are thus ineligible to graduate.
