Format:

- For the font use Calibri 12 point and set the line spacing at 1.5
- Include the heading information specified in the syllabus, aligned left at the top of the first page.

Title: Write a descriptive title for your response, centered below the heading.

Write an essay in response to the directions below. The word length should be a minimum of 700 and a maximum of 800 words.

- Review the characters you've studied in the course stories, plays, and poems and determine which of them you judge most and least admirable based on their morals or an ethical decision they have made.
- Rank **eight** of these characters from **eight** different works in order of their goodness or evil nature. Include the character and title of the work, identify the virtue (or vice) each character demonstrates and why, and state the **rationale** for your ranking. You may list all good or all evil characters or a combination.
- In your essay explain what you learned from the characters' struggles.
- Include cited quotations from **three** of the works to support your assessment. Avoid dropped quotes.

Criteria for evaluation (grading):

- clarity of controlling idea or thesis
- quality of evidence (supporting details)
- effective organization
- proper grammar and style (sentence structure and variety); correct spelling and word usage
- documentation of sources according to MLA
- thoroughness in analyzing and in following directions of the assignment
