Final approval has been given to the academic matters acted upon at the May 11, 2010 meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee.

Business & Technology Division

1. Create an Insurance Certificate, effective Fall 2010.
 - a. Create a new course, INS 121 Principles of Liability and Property Insurance, effective Fall 2010.
 - b. Create a new course, INS 122 Principles of Personal Insurance, effective Fall 2010.
 - c. Create a new course, INS 123 Principles of Commercial Insurance, effective Fall 2010. Note friendly amendment to remove the prerequisite of “a passing grade on AICPCU national exams INS 21 and INS 22.”
 - d. Create a new course, INS 125 Delivering Insurance Services, effective Fall 2010. Note friendly amendment, to remove the prerequisite of “a passing grade on AICPCU national exams INS 21 and INS 22.”
2. Create a Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning Certificate.

1. NUR 100 Paramedic to RN Bridge
 - a. Change prerequisite from BIO 111 to BIO 112
 - b. Remove prerequisite of ENG 101
2. NUR 101 Nursing Transition I
 - a. Change course title to “Advanced Placement Nursing I”
 - b. Change prerequisite from BIO 111 to BIO 112
3. NUR 103 Current Concepts in Nursing and Health Care I
 - a. Change corequisite from BIO 111 to BIO 112
 - b. Remove corequisite of ENG 101
4. NUR 104 Fundamentals of Nursing
 - a. Change corequisite from BIO 111 to BIO 112
 - b. Remove corequisite of ENG 101
5. NUR 105 Medical Surgical Nursing I/Maternal Newborn
 - a. Remove prerequisites of BIO 111, ENG 101, and PSY 101
 - b. Remove corequisite of BIO 112

Mathematics & Social Sciences Division

1. In the General Studies Associate in Arts program, change the mathematics requirement from “Mathematics Elective” to “MAT 100, MAT 121, or MAT 122 or any college-level MAT course” (note friendly amendment)
2. In the General Studies/Deaf Studies Transfer Option:
 - a. Change the mathematics requirement from “MAT 100 College Algebra” to “MAT 121 Topics in Mathematics or MAT 122 Statistics”
 - b. Designate SCI 108 Science of Technology: Hearing and Sound as a lab science option.
