

A Telephone Call: Character Biography

Directions:

1. Gather together in small groups (three or four students each) and **document at least five similarities** between each member of your group and the main character of “A Telephone Call.” Be very specific. This will help you connect with the next task.
2. After you have compiled the list of similarities, your group will write a single biography for the main character. Ask each other: what sort of person was she? Be sure to extract evidence from the text and source it by paragraph. Example, if I wrote: *The man called the woman “darling” (p4), which indicates his attraction to her.* You can see in my sentence I sources paragraph 4.
3. Remember a biography is a life story. So give good thorough details using context clues and evidence from the text.
