

New to QCC? Planning to transfer right away? QCC has the courses to help you get there.

NOTE: The courses listed here are general categories for those commonly accepted by four-year colleges and universities. They are only suggested courses. To be fully sure that a course you plan to take will be accepted by another college, you have a couple of options:

1. Visit the QCC Transfer Office website

and click on "Course Equivalencies" for available listings, or
2. Contact the colleges you are interested in and ask them to confirm transferability of a course.

<u>Courses</u>	<u>Credits</u>	<u>QCC Examples</u>
English	6 credits	ENG 101, 102
Humanities	6-9 credits	ART, ASL, ENG Literature, MUS, PHI, FRC, GER, SPN
Math	3-6 credits	MAT 100, 122, 123, 233, 234
Natural Sciences (at least one lab science)	4-8 credits	AST, BIO, CHM, PHY, SCI,
Social Sciences	6-9 credits	ANT, ECO, GEO, HST, PSC, PSY, SOC, SOS

In total this comes out to between 25-38 transferable credits that will fit into what most four-year colleges and universities call "General Education requirements" or "Graduation requirements." These are courses you will have to complete before you are awarded the Bachelor's degree, so you may want to consider taking them here.
