

Transfer Checklist---Seven Simple Steps

1. Research

Careers. You need to know the kinds of credentials/degrees needed.

&

Colleges. Not all colleges offer the same degrees. Locate the ones offering yours. The QCC Library has college guides. You can also search online.

2. **Identify** terms and jargon. Get to know words like “articulation,” “equivalency,” “Joint admissions,” “gen ed” or “distribution” requirements, among others.

3. **List** colleges based on your research. Include the pros and cons for each.
Use the other side of this paper to organize your steps.

4. **Talk** with your advisor and the Transfer Coordinator.

5. **Attend** on-campus and off-campus transfer events. Get to know what these schools have to offer.

6. **Estimate** cost. You may need to consider (or continue with) financial aid. Inquire about transfer scholarships at the four-year schools of interest.

7. **Apply.** Read and follow all directions. Pay attention to deadlines.

Remember: Make sure that your final official QCC transcripts are sent to the school at which you plan to enroll.
